A Level 1 Production Fabricator is responsible for fabricating exhibit parts based on shop drawings within the standards and directives of the Lead Fabricator. The main objective is to take raw materials and turn them into finished parts; to take a client's vision and make it reality. Assisting all other production employees when necessary with lifting, repetitive tasks and clean up. Must be able to consistently lift 50 lbs. and must be able to be on your feet all day.

Essential Functions and Responsibilities:

- Machining, cutting, and assembling of all material per the drawings and direction from the Lead Fabricator
- Confirm an understanding of required outcomes with the Lead Fabricator before commencing production
- Initiate review of exhibit components by the Lead Fabricator on a regular basis
- Pack projects for shipping as directed
- Participate in the installation effort; as needed
- Perform shop cleanup and basic equipment maintenance daily
- Work within the budgeted hours
- Record time accurately in Epicor
- Accurately document all stock materials used during the manufacturing process
- Maintain knowledge and skills in all areas of fabrication
- Report all injuries, potential work area hazards, and unsafe practices to the Wood Shop Manager immediately
- Maintain a positive and supportive work environment that encourages the sharing of information and ideas-situational awareness and courtesy for fellow workers
- Performs other duties as assigned. The omission of specific duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position

Minimum candidate requirements:

- Basic shop math skills (decimals, fractions, equations)
- Previous experience in an art/production/manufacturing type environment
- Experience working from shop drawings and verbal instruction
- Experience with and proper use of; a wide variety of hand and power tools; reading measuring devices
- Ability to work beyond normally scheduled hours that could include nights, and weekends
- Must be able to communicate easily and clearly in English, both written and spoken
- Must be able to legally work for any employer in the United States of America
