Assisting all other production artists when necessary with lifting, repetitive tasks and clean up. Must be able to lift 50 lbs. and must be able to be on your feet all day.

- Ability to travel out of town, state, and country for installations
- Must be able to communicate easily and clearly in English, both written and spoken
